SLOODLE (Simulation Linked Object Oriented Dynamic Learning Environment) is a free plug-in for the popular Open Source web-based virtual learning environment 'Moodle' (<http://www.moodle.org>), which integrates Moodle and Second Life. Alternatively... SLOODLE is a free plug-in for the popular 3D virtual world, 'Second Life' (<http://www.secondlife.com>), which enhances the existing support for learning and teaching through integration with the Open Source Moodle learning environment. What does SLOODLE do? Like other learning technologies, it is ultimately up to tutors and students to decide how tools should be used in class – but hopefully a list of some of the key features will give you some idea of the possibilities. \* Web-intercom. A chat-room that brings Moodle chatroom and Second Life chats together. Students can participate in chats in Second Life using the accessible Moodle chatroom.
